This match is being held on a trial basis to enable RNBRA and LGGC to assess the level of demand for competition using basic equipment under conditions which enable such basic equipment to be competitive without high cost. Under no circumstance will such a match be allowed to change into a high-price equipment race.

The match will be open to any resident of New Brunswick.

Entry fee is \$10.00 per shooter plus \$5.00 per additional entry fee to a maximum of 3 entries per shooter. This will be subject to Match Director's decision as to time availability depending on the number of entries.

Equipment rules are outlined in the following table.

RNBRA will provide medals for first, second and third place high scores. A shooter can win only one such medal.

There will be a separate medal for junior shooters who are under 18 years of age.

It is recommended that anyone wishing to enter the Championship should consider attending one or more of the informal monthly competitions presently being held by a group of local members of LGGC and their guests.

If you don't have equipment, a loaner rifle will always be available. We recommend that you not purchase any equipment unless you are certain that it is eligible.
